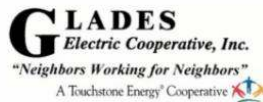

Overview of the CareerSource Heartland Region
Not Seasonally Adjusted
March 13, 2023

- The unemployment rate in the CareerSource Heartland region (DeSoto, Hardee, Highlands, and Okeechobee counties) was 3.4 percent in January 2023. This rate was 1.1 percentage points lower than the region's year ago rate of 4.5 percent. The region's January 2023 unemployment rate was 0.8 percentage point above the state rate of 2.6 percent. The labor force was 76,630, down 59 (-0.1 percent) over the year. There were 2,610 unemployed residents in the region.
- Okeechobee County had the lowest unemployment rate (2.7 percent) in the CareerSource Heartland region followed by DeSoto County (3.0 percent), Hardee County (3.3 percent), and Highlands County (3.9 percent).
- Employment by industry in the CareerSource Heartland region totaled 55,458 jobs in September 2022 (the latest available data). CareerSource Heartland region's employment increased by 1,222 jobs (+2.3 percent) over the year.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year were Education and Health Services (+444 jobs); Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+438 jobs); Professional and Business Services (+327 jobs); Leisure and Hospitality (+83 jobs); Financial Activities (+66 jobs); and Other Services (+32 jobs).
- The industries losing jobs over the year were Natural Resources and Mining (-119 jobs); Construction (-45 jobs); Information (-20 jobs); Manufacturing (-17 jobs); and Government (-9 jobs).

Sebring Metro Area

- In January 2023, nonagricultural employment in the Sebring MSA was 27,100, an increase of 300 jobs (+1.1 percent) over the year.
- The Government (+2.4 percent) industry grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The Government (+100 jobs) industry gained jobs over the year.

More than \$600 Million Annual Economic Impact

SEBRING, Fla. March 14, 2013 – Events at Sebring International Raceway generate an annual economic impact of \$603.7 million, according to a study conducted by the Florida State University Center for Economic Forecasting and Analysis.

Headlined by the Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring, which is an internationally recognized Mobil 1 WeatherTech Rolex Sports Car Series endurance race each March, and more than 300 additional events, the annual impact of Sebring International Raceway Events is the largest of any motorsports venue in the world and reflects unique characteristics such as world-class facilities, the Sebring race track, the Sebring Museum of Speed and Motorsports and the Sebring Raceway Village. While the Sebring race track has fewer than 70,000 seats, annual attendance at Sebring International Raceway events exceeds 1.2 million, and part-time race fans, and the Raceway's significant capacity to full-time weekend guests is highly sought after by international racing events such as the Rolex American Le Mans Series and the Rolex 24 Hours of Daytona.

The research was led by Dr. Julie Harter, the director of the FIE program who holds a doctorate in Economics and an MS in Education from Auburn University and has an extensive background in economics, econometrics, statistical analysis and educational research. Sebring International Raceway is owned by NASCAR Properties, which is a wholly owned subsidiary of Speedway Motors, LLC. Since 2004, NASCAR, NASCAR Properties, Sebring International Raceway and Five Brothers, a private Florida and entrepreneur-owned financing, selling and entertainment company, have teamed up to create a world-class motorsports and entertainment destination.

In total, NASCAR properties have an impact for exceeding \$1 billion on local economies and the State of Florida.

Highlands County Habitat for Humanity is hiring a full time Executive Director. To apply, see job description and application information below.

Overview: Highlands County Habitat for Humanity, Inc. (HCHH) is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization seeking to provide a home for every family in need. The organization helps individuals and families achieve strength, stability and self-reliance through shelter. In addition to building new homes, Highlands County Habitat for Humanity also repairs and renovates existing housing structures for low and just housing policies, helps and assists other natural disasters. As a major fundraising initiative, Habitat accepts and re-sells donated household materials through our ReStore. The geographical service area for HCHH covers Avon Park, Sebring, Lake Wales and Lorida. Florida HCHH has a \$1.5 million operating budget and \$5 million in total assets. The affiliate funds approximately 40 homes per year and has a history of aid and support to existing homes again. The affiliate operates with a paid, full-time staff of 10 and more approximately 200-250 volunteers per year. The affiliate has a governance board of 12 directors.

Basic Functions: The Executive Director provides overall executive leadership to the affiliate in accordance with the directives, policies and objectives set by the affiliate board of directors and Habitat for Humanity International. The Executive Director accepts the consent of Habitat for Humanity and is a leading advocate of the affiliate in regard to fulfilling the mission and vision statements. This position is responsible for recruiting, planning and managing the operations of the organization. The Executive Director is a non-voting, ex-officio member of the board of directors and reports to the executive committee.

Job Skills: Reporting to the position: Construction Manager, ReStore Manager, Finance Manager, Volunteer Manager, Development Manager, Homeownership Program Manager and Office Coordinator

General Administration

- Act as the chief administrator responsible for managing all aspects of affiliate operations and development of a strategic plan in partnership with the board of directors.
- Oversee the management of personnel, human resources, financial, human development and critical repair programs, homeownership programs, mortgage servicing, land acquisition, resale operations, resource development, and grant administration.
- Manage the affiliate office by planning, training, supervising, and recruiting for the paid and volunteer staff in the performance of assigned duties. Conduct regular reviews of staff performance.
- Establish office procedures, guidelines and performance standards.
- Maintain a climate which attracts, keeps, and motivates staff and volunteers.
- Ensure communication of relevant information flows among all groups.
- Ensure the affiliate adheres to government regulations and Habitat for Humanity International (HIMI) policies.

Financial Management

- Responsible for the development and maintenance of sound financial practices.
- Monitor the financial condition to ensure compliance of audits and other financial activities.
- Monitor confidential employee and Finance Family applied records for the affiliate and its subsidiaries.
- Work with the staff, Executive Committee, and board in preparing a yearly budget. Ensure that the affiliate operates within budget guidelines.
- Ensure that adequate funds are available to permit the organization to carry out its mission. This includes development of a fundraising plan in partnership with the Development Manager.
- Monitor the administrative cost to total cost ratio and act to ensure the ratio is kept at a level consistent with local and other guidelines.
- Work closely with the Finance Manager and CPA staff to ensure income and expenses are coded appropriately and quarterly financial statements are prepared in advance of board meetings.
- Grant compliance and reporting in partnership with the Development Manager.
- Ensure cash flow and expenditures for all bank accounts.
